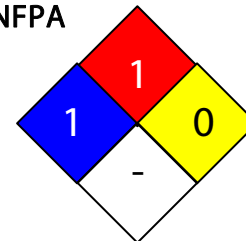
SECTION 4 -- FIRST AID MEASURES

Skin Contact: IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
Inhalation: IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferable mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.
Ingestion: IF SWALLOWED: Call a doctor or get medical attention. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Avoid aspiration into lungs. Have conscious victim rinse out mouth with water, thin drink sips of water to remove taste. In general no further treatment is necessary.
